





## HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

College have separate hostels for boys and girls. Boys' Hostels is aimed with maximum of 50% total boys' accommodation whereas the girls hostel has capacity for all girls students as per AICTE norms. Many affordable facilities are available in the vicinity of the college campus. The authority reserves the right to frame the rules, regulation and charges and committed to provide the basic requirements in all the hostels only.

Hostel seats are limited. No 1<sup>st</sup> year male student can be accommodated in hostel at present. Students intending to avail hostel facility should submit the filled-up Application Form for hostel along with documents at the Admission Section of CGEC. The Hostel Allotment List will be published on the College Website and on the College Notice Board on availability of seats.

#### **Hostel Charges:**

The Student wants Hostel accommodation are require to pay the following charges for hostel accommodation when hostel is allotted to him/her by the college authority.

#### **Hostel (Mess) Advance:**

Mess advance of Rs 10000/- (one time) will have to be deposited at the time od admissoion (applicable for the session 2020-21). In hostel only two principal meals will be provided.

Fresh students allowed hostel accommodation will, therefore required to deposit **Rs 14700/-** only by a demand draft from any nationalize bank in favor of "Cooch Behar Government Engineering College" payable at Cooch Behar.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1.Students should registrar their names, addresses, phone no., addresses of local guardian's etc. to hostel super at the time of hostel accommodation.
- 2. Student must not leave hostel before prior application to hostel super.
- 3. Student have to inform hostel super for their night stay outside.
- 4. Student have to take prior permission to keep guest with him.
- 5. Students will not be allowed to stay outside the hostel after 9:30 p.m.positively.
- 6.Hostel super should allot rooms provisionally for one year. Any change will not be allowed without prior permission.
- 7. Students must keep studying environment in the hostel.
- 8. Consumption of alcohol, smoking, taking restricted drugs is strictly prohibited in hostel and also in the college campus.
- 9.In any case of ragging, Hostel super will follow the Govt. rules strictly.
- 10. Viewing television is not permitted after 11.00 p.m. except special occasions and students have to take prior permission from the hostel super for that.
- 11. Students will not be allowed to bring objectionable C.D./
- D.V.D./V.C.R./V.C.Pto the hostel and sound of their music system/ computer speakers must not hamper the serenity of the other students.
- 12. Meal Time: Morning 8.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. Evening 9.00p.m. to 10.30 p.m. Meal reporting: Morning before 7.00 a.m. Evening before 7.00p.m.
- 13. Using heater, electric Iron is strictly prohibited. Students should take care about misuse of electricity.
- 14. Ladies/ Girls guests are not allowed to enter the Boys' hostel.
- 15. Gents/ Boys guests are not allowed to enter the Girls' hostel.
- 16. In any case of violation of rules or gross misbehavior or damaging the installed properties of the hostel/ college, the hostel super has the authority to cancel the boarder ship of the alleged student or refer to the higher authority for punishment without showing any cause.

A student should apply for hostel facility only if she/he agrees with the above rules and regulations.

# DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

Candidates become eligible for admission in Cooch Behar Government engineering College in 1st Year of B.Tech. after counseling by **West Bengal Joint Entrance Examination Board (WBJEEB)** according to the merit of the candidates and the availability of the seats in Cooch Behar Government Engineering College.

After counseling, candidates willing to take admission in Cooch Behar Government engineering College in 1st Year of B.Tech., are required to submit before the admission desk along with the duly filled specified admission form (downloadable from the website):

- a) ORIGINAL & SELF ATTESTED PHOTOCOPIES (2 copies each) of (i) Class X AdmitCard, (ii) Class X Mark Sheet, (iii) H.S./ Equivalent Mark Sheet/ Diploma mark sheet(for lateral admission) (iv) JEE Admit Card and Rank Card (ifapplicable) (v)Allotmentcertificate of WBJEEB (as issued from Reporting Centre)(original and photocopy)and (vii) Caste Certificate/ PH certificate (if any)
- b) ORIGINAL CHARACTER CERTIFICATE from the Head of the institution last attended (Keep one attested photocopy with your own custody)
- c) IN CASE OF BREAK OF STUDIES, a self-declaration certificate is to besubmitted by the student and countersigned by the guardian.
- d) ORIGINAL ANNUAL INCOME CERTIFICATE OF FATHER/GUARDIAN(optional exceptfor TFW Candidates): should have been issued by an Officer of the StateGovernment in the Rank of Block Development Officer or Sub-Divisional Officer or Additional District Magistrate or District Magistrate / Group-A Gazette Officer of State or Central Government of similar Rank or above.

OR

Executive Officer of Municipality/ Assistant Commissioner or above in Municipal Commissionerate.


- e) ORIGINAL MIGRATION CERTIFICATE Students who are studying in any Collegeaffiliated to University other than West Bengal University of Technology (WBUT)need to submit Migration Certificate during admission.
- f) 2 (two) COPIES STAMP SIZE COLOUR PHOTOGRAPH (without attestation)withfull signature on the back side and soft copy in CD.

- g) DOMICILE CERTIFICATE: The Domicile Certificate as applicable should be obtained fromany of the following competent authorities (i) District Magistrate, (ii) Additional DistrictMagistrate, (iii) Deputy Magistrate and Deputy Collector, (iv) Sub-Divisional Officer, (v)Block Development Officer, (vi) Superintendent of Police, (vii) AdditionalSuperintendent of Police, (viii) Sub-Divisional PoliceOfficer or Deputy Superintendentof Police, (ix) Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, DeputyCommissioner, AssistantCommissioner of Police Commissionerate, (x) JudicialMagistrate of any rank or position in the concerned district of Metropolitan locality orJudges/Judicial Officers of Hon'ble High Court at Kolkata or Hon'ble Supreme Court ofIndia, (xi) Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, AssistantCommissioner of Municipal Corporation, (xii) Executive Officer of Municipality, (xiii)Assistant Secretary / equivalent or above in the Secretariat to the Government. of WestBengal (including GTA) or Central Government, (xiv) Deputy Director or above in the Directorate to the Govt. of West Bengal or Central Government.
- h) FITNESS CERTIFICATE for General, Health & Eye to be produced from a RegisteredMedical Practitioner. The Certificate of Blood Group is to be obtained from anauthorized laboratory and submitted during admission.
- i)ANTI-RAGGING AFFIDAVITS: Students need to submit TWO anti-ragging affidavits as per Annexure-I and Annexure-II (downloadable from the website)in a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.10/-before an Oath Commissioner.
- j) Requisite amount of admission fee in Demand Draft. No other mode of payment will be accepted.\*For admission in reserved seats for scheduled castes (SC), scheduled tribes (ST),Other Backward Classes (OBC), Physically Handicapped (PH), candidates will beentertained only on submission of a certificate in support of his/ her caste signed byappropriate authority as per rule.

Note: Admission will be refused if original Certificates/Documents, affidavits and corresponding attested photocopies of certificates/documents are not presented/submitted at the time of admission.


