## Introduction to ECE Department

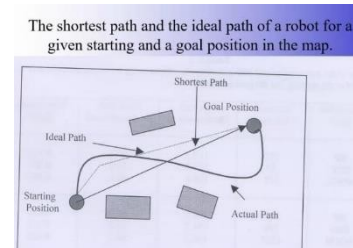
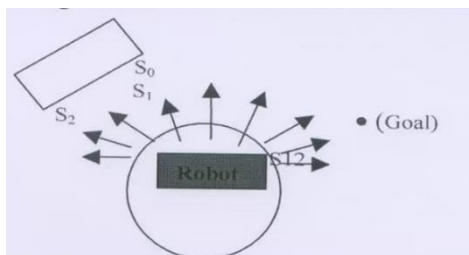

## Presidential Election

The session was conducted by Dr. Kaushik Ghosh Sir on the topic “Election Procedure of The President of India”. An indirect election system is adopted due to the huge population of the country; to avoid wastage of time and money and also to avoid conflict with the Prime Minister. According to Article 58, the president of India should have a few qualifications. He/she must be a citizen of India and should be at least 35 years old; have the capacity to become a member in the Lok Sabha; should not be a member in the Parliament or State Legislature and should not hold any office of profit. The president is indirectly elected by an Electoral College comprising elected members of the Parliament and elected members of the State Legislature. This system is known as ‘proportional representation by means of single transferable’.



### VALUE OF 1 M.L.A’S VOTE IN PRACTICE

- Value of Vote of an MLA of (for example) West Bengal in the Presidential Election 2017
- Total Population of West Bengal (1971 Census) = 443,12,011
- Total Number of Elected Members of the State Assembly = 294
- The Value of Votes of each MLA =  $\frac{44312011}{294 \times 1000} = 151$





If the candidate with the highest no. of votes fails to clear the quota, then counting is done for the second time. In the second time, the candidate with the least no. of votes is not taken into consideration. The ballots that had chosen the candidate with least no. of votes as their first preference is taken and the vote is given to the candidate of the second preference. This process is repeated until a candidate clears the quota. A candidate can still be elected as the president if he/she is the last and the only candidate.

### **ABOUT MAR:**

- MAR stands for Mandatory Additional Requirements.
- A student should acquire a total of minimum 100/75 activity points throughout 4 year/3 year curriculum which should be acquired by earning a minimum of 20 activity points and maximum of 30 activity points in each year of his/her study, which is necessary for uniform distribution of MAR activities throughout the entire period of the academic curriculum of the students.
- It's mandatory to pass a semester.
- A student's result of his/her Final Examinations will be withheld until he/she completes the minimum Activity Points by the end of his/her B.Tech Program.

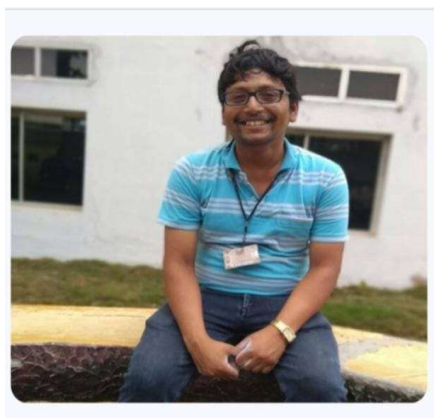
## RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

The students loved his session as he explained about different humanities department, the course of study and they are much excited to have his physics class as he is an excellent teacher who gave them his valuable time.



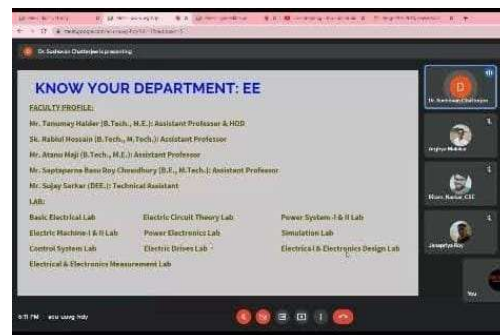
## Introduction to EE department

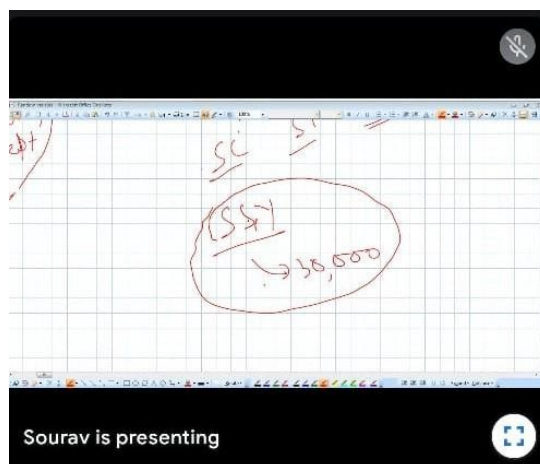

## Introduction to Examination

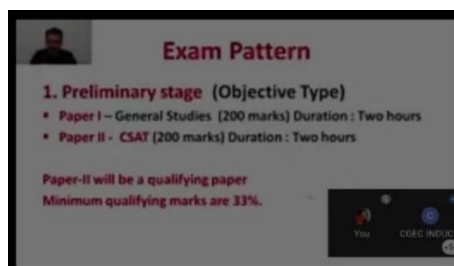

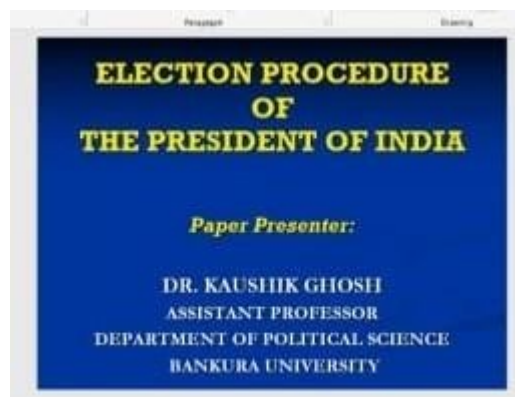


## Political Science

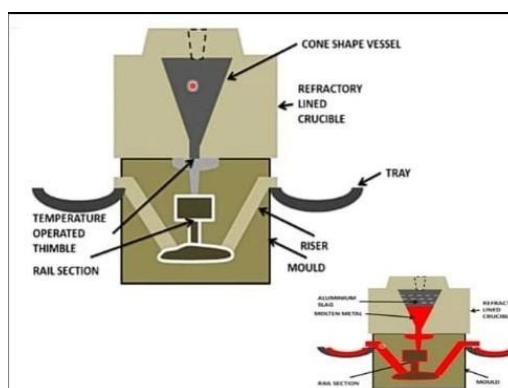
## Introduction to Welding

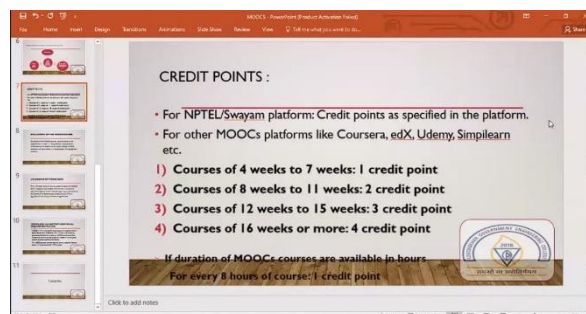


## NPTEL

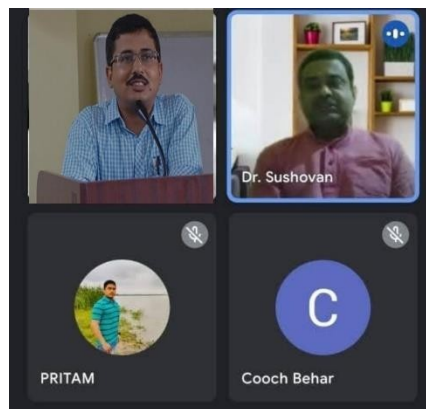

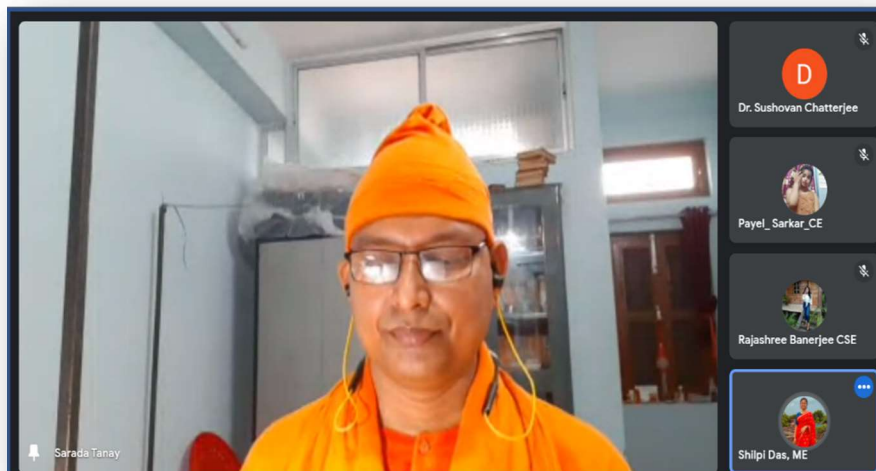


## *The way you see life*

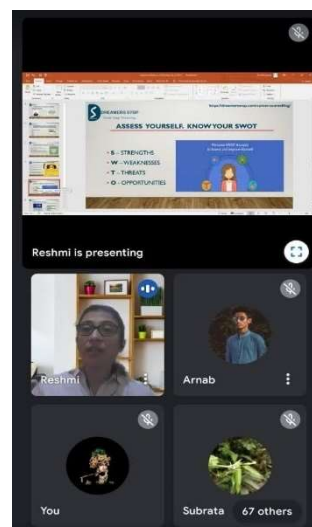


# Career Counselling

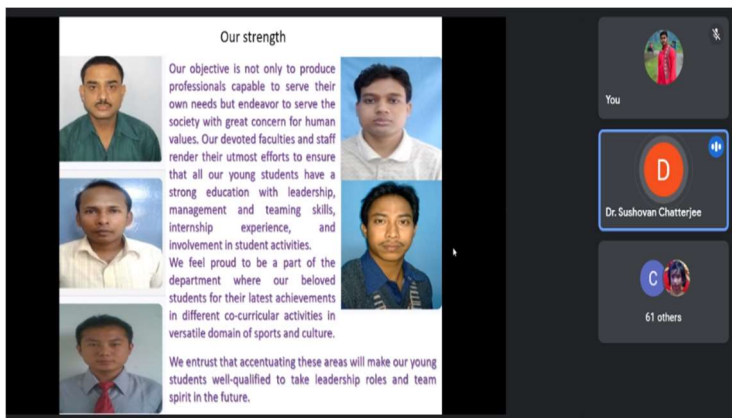
## Introduction To Mechanical Department

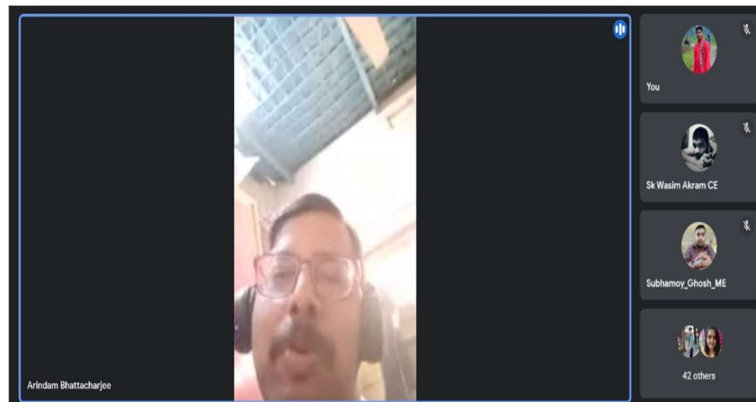


# YOGA

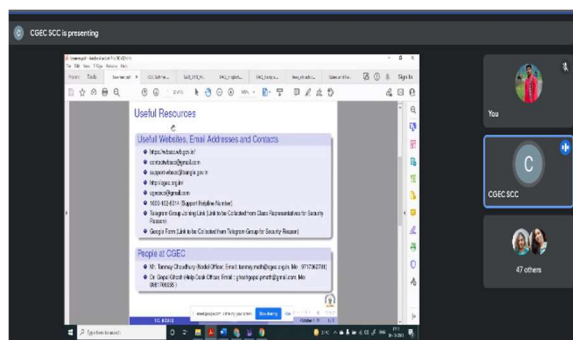
She also told them about hostel fees structure.

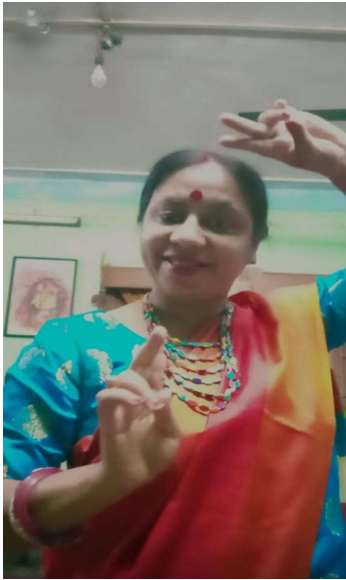
## Dance

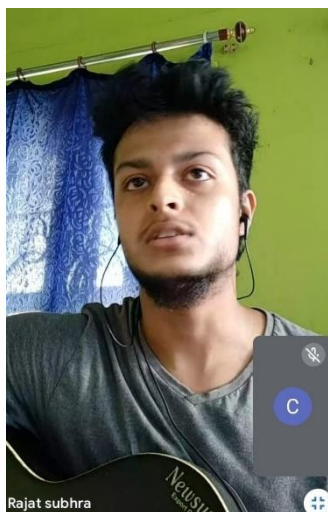

The induction programme comprised of many academic sessions representing the respective departments, some administrative rules, regulations and functions that CGEC is following now. We also had a priceless discussion about many





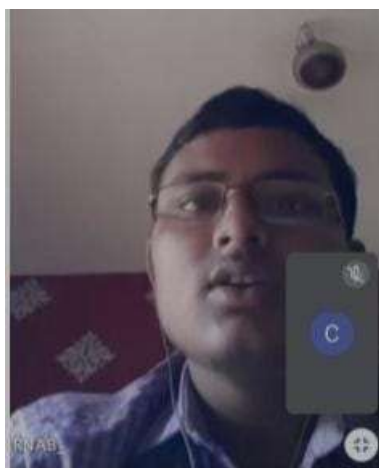

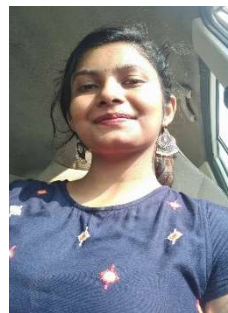
